A. Introduction:

- 1) The Government of the Federal Republic of Nigeria has received financing from the World Bank toward the cost of the Immunization Plus and Malaria Progress by Accelerating Coverage and Promoting Services (IMPACT) Project and intends to apply part of the proceeds for consulting services.
- The National Primary Health Care Development Agency (NPHCDA) is a parastatal of Nigeria's Federal Ministry of Health with the corporate goals to; control preventable diseases and eradicate polio, improve access to basic health services, improve quality of care, develop highperforming health workforce, strengthen the primary health care institutions, partnerships, and community engagement.
- The World Bank supports the Government of Nigeria to strengthen primary health care and reduce under-5 mortality rates through a Multiphase Programmatic Approach (MPA) intervention. The MPA has 3 phases, starting with the IMPACT project. The IMPACT project is a significant investment in the Nigeria health sector with ambitious targets for service improvement and strengthening health systems.
- The project development objective of the IMPACT phase of the MPA is to improve the utilisation and quality of immunisation plus (immunisation, child, neonatal and maternal health) and malaria services in selected states.
- The project has four components; (1) Malaria Control; (2) Immunisation plus; (3) Knowledge for Change; and (4) Contingency Emergency Response Components (CERC) and will be implemented in a total of 20 states. 4 States of Borno, Imo, Lagos and Rivers will implement component 1 on malaria control, and 19 States of Abia, Adamawa, Bauchi, Benue, Delta, Ebonyi, Ekiti, Gombe, Kaduna, Kano, Kogi, Kwara, Nasarawa, Oyo, Ondo, Plateau, Sokoto, Yobe and Zamfara will implement component 2, the immunisation plus component of the project.
- 6) The project will be implemented by two Project Implementing Units (PIUs) at the Federal level situated at the National Malaria Elimination Program (NMEP) for components 1 and 3 and at the National Primary Health Care Development Agency (NPHCDA) for components 2 and 3. Similarly, at the State level, the PIUs at SMEP will implement Component 1 in the Malaria States and SPHCBs, and Component 2 in the Immunization Plus States.
- The immunisation-plus component of the project includes high-impact and innovative RMNCAH+N interventions that will focus on improving the availability, uptake and quality of perinatal and post-natal services, which will contribute to addressing neonatal mortality and, as a continuum, improve under-five morbidity, including malnutrition, and under-five mortality.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

The shortlisting criteria are:

Essential Minimum Qualifications and Experience

- Minimum of five years relevant experience in PHC activities.
- 2. Background in Midwifery, Nursing, Medical Laboratory Technology, Health Technology, Maternal and Child Health, Public Health, Health Economics/Health Management, Health Information Management or Public Policy is desired.
- 3. In-depth understanding of the Nigerian health system and RMNCAH+N (Basic Emergency Obsterics and Newborn Care (BEmONC), Essential Newborn Care Course (ENCC), Modified/Life-Saving Skills (MLSS/LSS)).
- 4. Significant Knowledge on Immunization programs at the LGA level (RI services, Logistics and Vaccine Management, data management, advocacy and community mobilization etc).
- Strong problem-solving skills and experience working under demanding work plans, and fast-paced environments.
- Experience organising training, conducting field visits, and providing support to health facilities.
- 7. Strong diplomatic and interpersonal relationship skills; experience working with partners and traditional institutions at community and LGA levels.
- 8. Ability to understand and speak local language.
- 9. Technical proficiency with Microsoft Word, Excel and PowerPoint, with ability to use these tools to collect and analyse immunisation program data.
- 10. Good verbal, and written communication skills.
- 11. Ability to create written project reports and retire funds.
- 12. Previous experience working in a similar role in rural settings with limited infrastructure.
- Ability to travel within and outside the LGA and within the state of assignment.
- Ability to work independently and with minimal supervision.
- Experience with Results-Based Financing of Healthcare (DFF and PBF design or implementation) is an advantage.
